3. The document or application files must be restricted to the one domain which is registered for your license, but the number of files is not restricted.
4. The document or application files must retain all font property information, including TM and copyright strings.
5. Where the feature applies (i.e. Flash), the "Protect from Import" option must be enabled when the SWF files are generated.
6. Where the feature applies (i.e. Flash), configure sIFR's customize_me.as file in two ways to prevent unauthorized users from accessing the system: first, set the allowedDomains array to include only the domain of your website (instead of ""), and then set allowlocal to "false" before publishing the .swf to the web.
